Job Summary

The Digital Ministry Production Intern will be experienced in handling a wide range of digital media-related tasks and will be able to work independently. The intern must be exceedingly organized, flexible and enjoy the communications challenges of supporting a congregation of diverse people. They must have technological expertise and problem-solving skills to build, mobilize and improve church communications. The intern will report to the pastor and coordinate with the digital ministry team.

Responsibilities

1. Worship Preparation

- Serve as the producer and editor for all Sunday Services and additional services.
- Design worship slides and conduct sound checks prior to Sunday Services
- Arrive early on Sunday's to prepare equipment and elements for livestream
- Integrate all sound and visual elements in Open Broadcaster Software (OBS) during livestream of services
- Attend scheduled production meetings

2. Congregational & Ministry Communications

- Publish worship videos on church Youtube, Facebook, and website. Maintain consistent brand across church communications
- Update website content and fix any design/content errors on a weekly basis using WIX website builder. Regularly forward new subscribers to the pastor

Minimum qualifications

- College student pursuing degree in and/or equivalent work experience in Audio-Visual Design, Tech support, Communications, Art, Media, Religion and/or other related fields
- Working knowledge of live presentation software, Adobe Premiere Rush, Microsoft PowerPoint, Office 365 Suite, WIX, Facebook, and other software as appropriate
- Knowledge of lighting, camera use, audio recorders, and soundboard desired
- Experience working in a church environment desired
